INDOOR SHOOTING EVENTS – General Information

EVENTS (two, separate events):

- .22-Caliber Rifle Shooting (50-feet)
- .22-Caliber Pistol Shooting (25-feet)

LOCATION: Tanana Valley Sportsmen's Association (TVSA) Indoor Shooting Range (www.tvsa.us)
1230 TVSA Way (off Boat Street next to Best Western Hotel), Fairbanks, Alaska

CHECK-IN: Event check-in is at the range. **All firearms must be UNLOADED and CASSED upon arrival.** Competitors must check-in before the end of the allotted check-in time or may not be able to compete in the event.

ELIGIBILITY: Competitors must be 50 years of age or older (as per the AISG specified date) and must be able to safely handle and fire (shoot) the firearm(s) used in the event(s). **Competitors must make sure firearm(s) are safe to use and must be competent in safely handling, loading, firing and unloading any gun used in the competition, BEFORE the event(s). Competitors should sight-in and practice shooting with their firearm(s) well in advance of the event(s).**

DIVISIONS/BIBS: Competitors will be placed in individual men's and women's five-year age divisions beginning with age 50 and ending with 100+. Numbered Bibs (or a competitor number) will be issued at the event. If issued a Senior Games Bib for the event, please wear it (pinned to clothing on back) while competing in the indoor shooting event(s).

EQUIPMENT: *See the Event Rules for additional equipment details.*

- .22-caliber light rifle weighing 10 pounds or less, with iron/open or optical sights. Competitors must bring their firearm in a case.
- .22-caliber pistol with barrel length 10 inches or less, with iron/open or optical sights. Competitors must bring their firearm in a case.
- .22-caliber rimfire ammunition, .22LR only, safe and suitable for the firearms(s) used. (We recommend bringing 50 rounds minimum per event to allow for practice and record shots, as well as account for any dud rounds.)
- Eye and ear protection to use in the live-fire range.

PHOTOS/VIDEOS: By registering and participating in these events, you provide consent for photographs or video to be taken and used for promotion of the Senior Games, the hosting of the event and the safe and responsible participation in the shooting sports.

PROTESTS: *See the Event Rules for complete details on protests.*

Must be in writing and submitted to the Event Commissioner within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the game, match, heat or event under protest.
